Entry requirements:

Pre-requisite to enrolling in the skills set is;

- completion of the Mars College 4 module program.

- Describe natural behaviour patterns for at least two different animal species?
- Use industry terminology when recording observed behaviour?
- Recognise signs of stress and determine possible stressors in animals?

Have you:

- Managed maladaptive behaviours in animals?
- Implemented and reviewed enrichment programs for animals in your care?

Have you for at least 3 different animals with different dietary needs:

- Calculated and prepared diets?
- Distributed their food to meet their need and your workplace hygiene practices?
- Monitored and reviewed their diet in consultation with your supervisor?
